

Fagus Day Trip on June 7th 2018

Forde Abbey, Chard and Lytes Cary, Somerton, Somerset

Coach leaves Clevedon Rd carpark, Nailsea at 8.30, returning 5.30approx

Forde Abbey is a family owned ancient property, originally built by Cistercian monks almost 900 years ago. Today it is owned by the Kennard family who continue to live there. There is a 30 acre garden with a rockery, kitchen garden, bog garden and mature arboretum. In addition there is a plant nursery, pottery and gift shop.

Lytes Cary is a National Trust property, a medieval manor house, now restored after years of neglect. The garden has also been updated in the Arts and Crafts style, divided into rooms by yew hedges, with topiary and herbaceous borders.

COST: £36.00 for members of Fagus and the National Trust – non NT members will have an additional charge of £9.30.

Guests may apply from April 23rd, cost £ 40.00

The price includes coach fare, driver's tip, lunch at a local pub and entrance to Forde Abbey house and garden. Teas and coffees are available at both properties but are NOT included in this cost. Your cheque will be banked when we know the trip is viable.
